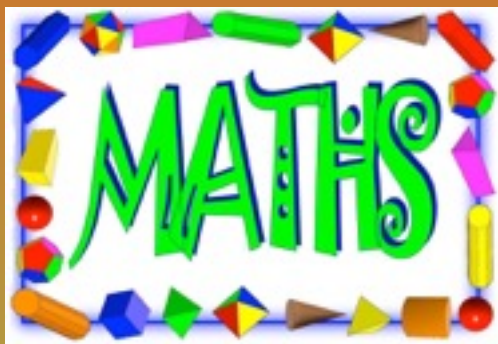
Our focus areas for literacy are: Description, reports, recount, explanations and narrative.
