Term 1 Curriculum Focuses

Maths - Develop our number knowledge skills 1-100, recall a number that comes before and after a given number, simple addition to 10/20 e.g 5+3, 12+4=

Reading - Develop our alphabet and basic word knowledge, read daily to develop reading confidence, discuss the illustrations & characters in the story, identify simple punctuation such as full stops and commas.

Writing - Use a simple picture plan to organise our ideas, verbally construct a sentence and write this, use a word card to locate alphabet letters and basic words to use in our stories.

Learning Modules - Weeks 1-4 'PapatoetoeTangata Pai' module, focused on getting to know each other and our school community better. In Week 5, we begin our 'NZ Histories' module, focused on understanding significant events and influential people in NZ.

Specialist Health and Physical Education Programme - This year your child will participate in fortnightly health and physical education lessons with our specialist teacher Mr Paul Drury. They will learn and develop their fine and gross motor skills and learn about how to care for their personal health.

We look forward to working with you to best support your child's learning.

Important Reminders

- Home learning expectations Spend 15-20mins each day reading with or to your child & discuss aspects of the story. Practise their alphabet/basic word knowledge and number skills up to 100.
